

Seeking a Certified Athletic Trainer

The Spine Team at Flagstaff Bone and Joint is seeking a certified Athletic Trainer (AT) to work as an essential member of their busy team. The Spine Team at Flagstaff Bone and Joint consists of two orthopaedic spine surgeons, one PM&R interventional spine physician, and two physician assistants. The AT will support the physicians with patient care by using AT's knowledge of the prevention, evaluation, rehabilitation and treatment of spine injuries and conditions in the clinical setting and will assist in surgery.

AT will assist the spine team in clinic:

- Greet patients in waiting area in a kind, courteous, and professional manner. Escort them to the proper exam room, obtain a thorough history, perform initial evaluation, organize previous medical studies/reports, and present patient to the supervising physician.
- If applicable, obtain diagnostic data for that patient i.e. follow-up X-ray prior to the supervising physician seeing patient.
- Expedite the necessary steps of continued care, for example; referrals for MRI, bracing, physical therapy, etc.
- Provide education to patients.
- Answer and take care of necessary patient phone calls, follow up on requests for such things as medication refills and medical leave forms.
- Assist with in-office procedures, home exercise programs, and bracing.
- Perform most of the visit documentation in order to free up the providers to spend more time with each patient.

AT will assist spine surgeons in surgery:

- Applicant must hold a current, or be eligible to take, the Orthopaedic Technologist Certification (OTC).

The Ideal Applicant Will Possess:

- A commitment to provide first-class, orthopaedic spine care to patients in the clinical setting.
- A strong desire to grow within the field of spine care.
- The ability to work both independently and as an effective team member.
- The ability to work with different providers each clinic day.
- Effective interpersonal skills to communicate both in person and in writing.
- Strong work ethic and ability to prioritize multiple tasks and follow through in a timely manner.
- Have initiative to ask questions, make proposals, and effectively problem solve.

- American Heart Association or American Red Cross CPR/AED certified
- Clean Background Check
